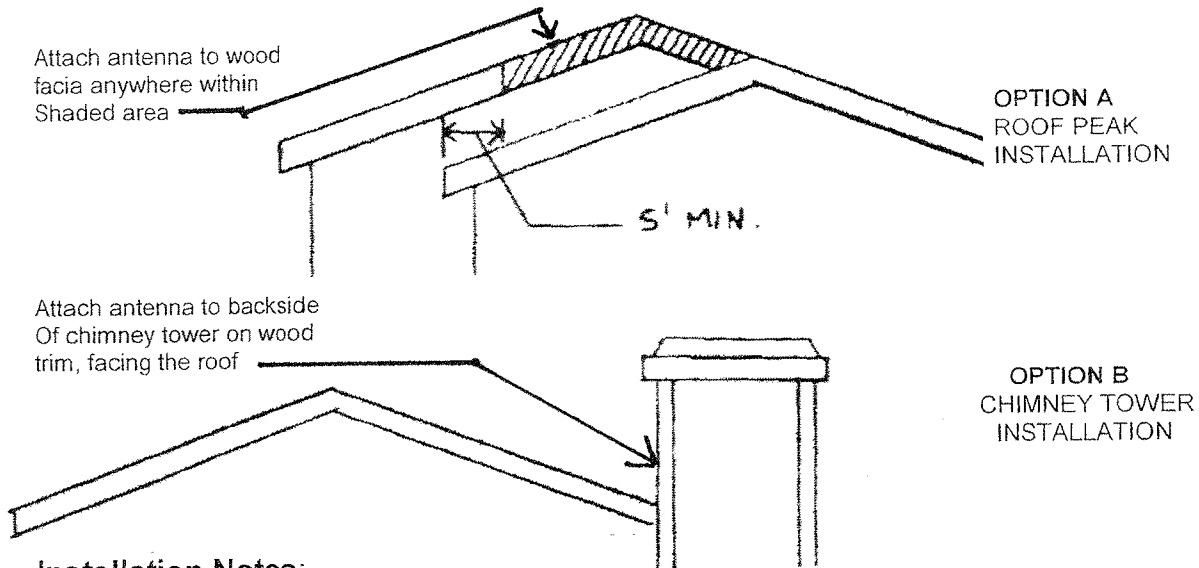

## SATELLITE DISH ANTENNA INSTALLATION GUIDELINES



### Installation Notes:

- No holes will be made in the composition roofing material.
- Locate your dish using the option above that best meets your reception needs.
- **Cabling will be the color of the building and run along eaves or trim to minimize visibility. (Association will paint cables)**
- Where cable must run down the roof, it must run straight down, not at an angle
- Cables can only run down the back side of the building (opposite of front door)
- Cables may never run anywhere in the front of the unit.
- Cables must enter unit through a vertical wall under the eaves through a weather-tight opening with a drip loop placed in the cable.
- Cable will enter the unit's interior as close as possible to the antenna location

### Owner Agrees To:

- Maintain the antenna(e) for appearance and safe working order
- Accept liability for all damages arising from installation or repair of antenna(e)
- Indemnify the Association from any liability or claims, demands, damages, costs or judgments related to the antenna(e)
- Reimburse the Association for any costs suffered as a result of the antenna(e)
- Remove the antenna(e) at the Association's request for the purpose of maintaining the roof or exterior building components
- Have the antenna(e) installed and/or removed by a licensed contractor with at least \$1,000,000 liability insurance
